Tensions Mount as South Korea Demands Immediate Withdrawal of North Korean Troops from Russia

Meanwhile, NATO has been urged to take immediate countermeasures, with South Korean President Yoon Suk-yeol calling for swift action against the burgeoning Russia-North Korea cooperation.

As the dust continues to settle, the world watches closely, holding its breath to see whether this bold gambit by North Korea and Russia will plunge the conflict in Ukraine into even darker waters. One thing is clear: this unholy alliance has ignited a fuse that may be difficult to extinguish.
